THE INFLUENCE OF WEATHER CONDITIONS ON BIOSPHERE PROCESSES

Abstract. The importance of meteorological processes and phenomena in the functioning of the biosphere is analysed. The influence of different weather conditions on health is shown, the factors and mechanism of their effects are described.
